The electricity service box was inspected and a contractor was arranged for to do a follow-up in late February 2016. The follow-up works are expected to complete in March.
					• The excavation works, which covered the locations of traffic sign posts, started in Wing Lok Street, Sheung Wan in May 2015. The entire project is expected to complete in September 2016. The LCSD has discussed with the HEC and requested it to complete the resurfacing works

The design of the sticker wrap was approved by the C&W DFMC during its second meeting held on 18 February 2016. The mounting of the sticker wrap is expected to complete in early April.
