Question on organising large-scale events during the epidemic

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the Tourism, Agriculture, Fisheries, Environmental Hygiene and Climate Change Committee meeting to be held on 29 March 2021:

“ Hong Kong Resort Company Limited (HKRCL), the developer of Discovery Bay organised Easter egg hunt during the Easter holidays in the past, attracting a large number of visitors.

This year, despite the development of the epidemic, the company organises “AR Easter Hunt” which lasts for three days and promotion is launched online (see photo attached), which is greeted with apprehension.

As such, I would like HKRCL to arrange representatives to attend the meeting to respond to the following:

1. Is it appropriate to organise large-scale events during the epidemic?
2. What measures will be taken to limit the number of visitors to Discovery Bay?
3. How to ensure social distancing is properly maintained among the participants to prevent an outbreak in the community?
4. How to minimise the nuisance to the residents?”
