Tuen Mun District Crime Report for Tuen Mun District Council Meeting Covering the Period from January to September 2024

I. GENERAL SITUATION

1. Overall Crime

- (1) There were 4,411 crime reports in Jan Sep 2024, up 1,310 reports or +42.2% compared with 3,101 reports in the same period last year. The rise was mainly due to the increase of:
 - Deception (up from 1,258 to 2,163 reports) (+905 reports / +71.9%) [accounting for 49% of total crimes];
 - Miscellaneous Thefts (up from 353 to 438 reports) (+85 reports / +24.1%) [accounting for 9.9% of total crimes]; and
 - Shop Theft (up from 435 to 482 reports) (+47 reports / +10.8%) [accounting for 10.9% of total crimes].

In Jan - Sep 2024, crimes showing significant decrease were:

- Theft from Vehicle (down from 45 to 22 reports) (-23 reports / -51.1%) [accounting for 0.5% of total crimes];
- Burglary (down from 42 to 24 reports) (-18 reports / -42.9%) [accounting for 0.5% of total crimes]; and
- Missing Motor Vehicles (down from 43 to 30 reports) (-13 reports / -30.2%) [accounting for 0.7% of total crimes].
- (2) The detection rate in Jan Sep 2024 was 29.3%, down 5% compared with 34.3% in in the same period last year.

- (1) There were 559 violent crime reports in Jan Sep 2024, up 182 reports or +48.3% compared with 377 reports in the same period last year.
- (2) The detection rate of violent crime was 55.1%, down 12% compared with 67.1% in the same period last year.

[➤] Online account Hijacking (up from 64 to 146 reports, û82/û128.1%)
