Tuen Mun District Crime Report for Tuen Mun District Council Meeting Covering the Period of 2023 and from January to November 2024

I. GENERAL SITUATION

1. Overall Crime

- (1) There were 5,376 crime reports in Jan Nov 2024, up 1,508 reports or +39% compared with 3,868 reports in the same period last year. The rise was mainly due to the increase of:
 - Deception (up from 1,582 to 2,700 reports) (+1,118 reports / +70.7%) [accounting for 50.2% of total crimes];
 - Miscellaneous Thefts (up from 422 to 530 reports) (+108 reports / +25.6%) [accounting for 9.9% of total crimes]; and
 - Pickpocketing (up from 10 to 26 reports) (+16 reports / +160%) [accounting for 0.5% of total crimes].

In Jan - Nov 2024, crimes showing significant decrease were:

- Theft from Vehicle (down from 56 to 23 reports) (-33 reports / -58.9%) [accounting for 0.4% of total crimes];
- Burglary (down from 53 to 35 reports) (-18 reports / -34%) [accounting for 0.7% of total crimes]; and
- Missing Motor Vehicles (down from 49 to 32 reports) (-17 reports / -34.7%) [accounting for 0.6% of total crimes].
- (2) The detection rate in Jan Nov 2024 was 29.2%, down 4.5% compared with 33.7% in in the same period last year.
